Summary



The Moscato d'Asti D.O.C.G. virtual tasting led by Italian wine expert, Jeff Porter and Consorzio per la Tutela dell'Asti D.O.C.G. Director, Giacomo Pondini, took place on Monday, August 31, 2020 through Zoom. The tasting showcased Moscato d'Asti DOCG latest vintage with the participation of the following winery representatives: Luigi Coppo, Marco Dogliotti, Stefano Chiarlo, Gianpiero Scavino, and Andrea Costa.

The World Wine Web Masterclass organized by I.E.M. and I.E.E.M., allowed participants to learn all about the history, wine making process and territory of all five participating wineries while tasting their featured wines:

Zoom connected me, lead by Jeff Porter and @ieemusa with the gorgeous green hills and valleys of Piedmont for an hour, as winemakers spoke about their Moscato d'Asti and I tasted through their wines. The picturesque winegrowing areas have been included as a UNESCO World Heritage site. Once this period of Covid is over, I highly recommend, you put it on your "must visit" list. Luigi Coppo @coppo1892, located in historic Canelli, who produces Moncalvino, called these moscatos "fresh, crisp, light, not cloying". This was so true because they are well balanced between acidity/sugar. He noted how historic the moscato bianco grape, its been planted in the area since at least the 12th century. Tasting his wine hit me how


refreshing it was, even though it was sweet. The aromas of moscato d'asti are like smelling a bouquet of white flowers. Besides Coppo, we heard and tasted #LaCaudrina Castiglione Tinella, Stefano Chiarlo, @michelechiarlo #dievole, Gianpero Scavino #vignaiolidisantostefano that Jeff called the "rocket" because of its unique bottle shape and Andrea Costa from @marencovini in Strevi and his single vineyard "Scrapona". Stefano Chiarlo talked about the different altitudes of the vineyards, all the vineyards are located on steephills, 218m -300m, (sometimes up to 400m in Marenco's case), and the notes of sage, apricot and peach in his wine. Gianpero talked about organic farming, the notes of white peach, apricot and sage and finally Andrea whose great grandfather, started the vineyard talked about how Moscato d'Asti always has a vintage on the label. He said " every variety (grape) in Piedmont has a reason to exist". His wine has interesting notes of passion fruit along with sage and peach. The chatbox was full of food pairing ideas, the traditional is desserts. But the winner of the day was BBQ, suggested by Jeff but it got lots of thumbs ups. My savory pairing is pad thai. Oh such a grogeous area and refreshing, delicate, aromatic wines, thank you to the producers for the time spent with us. @consorzio.asti.docg #moscatodasti






















